What/Why

Expectations

- You should be willing to be available to assist at each event (12 is the goal). However, as all members will likely not be needed for each event, you should be willing to assist the HEAT Coordinator in creating a fair and balanced workload for the Team.
- You should be available to attend monthly meetings and any additional event-specific meetings as deemed necessary by the HEAT Coordinator. You are responsible to notify the HEAT Coordinator in a timely manner if you are unable to attend.
- If you are unable to make a scheduled event, you are responsible for notifying the HEAT Coordinator during the planning stage and assisting him/her in finding a replacement.
- You should have a love for helping people connect, be willing to be led, be creative, and enjoy event planning.
- You must love Jesus and demonstrate a growing relationship with God.
