



JAM (Jesus and Me) or 724 (Youth) Leader - Position Charter

What

As a JAM/724 Leader, you will serve as a leader of a JAM small group, as well as assisting during large group time. You should be willing to:

- build relationships with the children/youth and engagingly teach them the weekly lesson
- work collaboratively with the other leaders on how you can provide the best environment for your group to grow in their faith and build godly relationships with those around them
- be willing to redirect distractions
- be outgoing to come alongside the kids/youth in all activities to build relationships
- love each child with the love you've been given from the Spirit and
- think of ways to encourage students to live out what they are learning in the lessons

Why

God loves these kids! One of the ways that He demonstrates His love is through people who have been captured by the love of Jesus and, in turn, pour out His love onto these children. God has commanded those who follow Jesus to make disciples and to equip the next generation to know Him intimately and to lead their own generation to Jesus.

Expectations

- This position will require up to 2 hours on a scheduled week, usually 10:30am – 12:15/30pm with some prior prep time as you deem necessary during the week.
- You will be scheduled with a team, per the local school calendar, usually three Sundays a month. When there is no school, there is no JAM/724 that weekend.
- On weeks when you are scheduled to serve, you should arrive for Leader prayer time at 10:30am.
- You must enjoy serving children.
- You must love Jesus and demonstrate a growing relationship with God.
- You must be willing to submit information for a Child Abuse Registry Check yearly.
